One of the main features of the service is a US toll-free number, (800) 457-6676, which is available from 10 AM to 5 PM EST. This line is staffed by Parkinson's information specialists who can answer most questions about Parkinson's disease, its treatments and therapies, research advances and coping strategies. If a question is beyond their training, they refer it to one of a dedicated group of neurologists and other healthcare specialists who are experts in the diagnosis and treatment of Parkinson's disease.

Our staff also maintains referral lists of experienced neurologists that cover most areas of the US and many major cities abroad. In most cases we are able to direct callers to a local support group.
